



You can help to grow your child's language skills

You can stimulate your child's language development through play, sharing books together or when out and about using Blank Levels of Questioning. As parents and teachers, we need to use the right level of language to help children to understand and feel confident about expressing themselves. It is important to remember that children learn best when we **share** information rather than being asked lots of questions. Try to follow your child's lead, add language to what they are doing or looking at. Leave plenty of time for your child to **take turns in conversation**.
