GETTING HELP:

Targeted Support: Goal focused, evidencebased and outcome focused interventions



Getting help from Shropshire Community Health Speech and Language Therapy (SLT) Services to Children and Young People with language difficulties:

- Settings to complete a language screen (e.g. EY Talk Boost/Talk Boost/NELI etc.) to identify those children who
 may require a referral to SLT.
- Settings to deliver an evidence based language programme by trained staff.
- SLT Advice line Parents/carers and setting staff can talk over the phone to an SLT to express concerns, seek advice and talk through assessment procedure, interventions and ongoing support 01743 450800
- Following the triage of a referral, a full language assessment may be offered where appropriate: This consists of a parental case history, and detailed assessment and interview with CYP. Any onward internal and external referrals can be made as required.

Individual Interventions:

- Outreach Support: assessment / monitoring by a SALT with therapy programmes delivered by a SALTA or trained TA in school to children who are waiting for more intensive support or whose needs cannot be met by one of the service's packages of care.
- Speech and Language Therapy Inclusion Service (SALTIS) operates across schools in Telford & Wrekin and is funded by the LA. The service is for children in Reception, Year 1 and year 2 classes who show significant delay in receptive and/or expressive language. This may include language difficulties which are the most significant part of an overall profile of early childhood developmental disability.
- **Telford Language Classes**: There are two classes operating in Telford and Wrekin. Children with developmental lagricare discular (DLD) seprences interpreted advection and interprise
